WHAT DOES IT FIND?

- AWE can facilitate learners' writing.
- When AWE provides students with negative feedback, students can identify errors in their language use, and improve their interlanguage development.
- Feedback provided by AWE is individualised.
- AWE allows learners to interact with the system and peers.
- Post-secondary students with higher proficiency in using technology can benefit more from AWE.
- AWE is relatively weak in providing feedback on argument quality and audience sensitivity.

HOW CAN I USE THE FINDINGS IN MY TEACHING?

- Additional technical training and support can be given to young learners when they first use AWE to ensure a smooth transition.
- Teachers can incorporate AWE with teacher and peer feedback.
- Teachers can help learners benefit more from AWE by facilitating their self-reflection.
